"Accessory Use" includes, but is not limited to, the following: (a) Residential accommodations for domestics or guests and not

- rented or otherwise used as a separate domicile and containing no kitchen facilities or separate utility meters. (b) Residential accommodations for caretakers or proprietors on the same lot with any use listed in Article 9, Section 9A-2. When "accessory" is used in the text, it shall have the same meaning as "Accessory Use."
- 2. Amend Section 9A-2 (16.) to read as follows: 16. Accessory buildings and uses to include accessory residential
