Mr. Dooley then presented the Board a revised Statement of Basis for Offer on Project No. F.A.S. 23-RS-1084(3), Lecompton Road Project, for Tract No. 3, the owner of which is Mark S. and Deborah D. Boose with the just compensation as determined through appraisal to be \$4065 which will be used as an offer to these individuals for the purchase of right-of-way easement.
