Mr. Dooley then presented the Board an Agreement between Mobil Pipeline Company and Douglas County for Project 23C-1188-01, Formerly 23-SOS-432(1). Douglas County intends to improve a portion of Douglas County Road No. 102 and replace Bridge No. 20.30N-6.11E described as follows: Beginning at a point on the center line of Douglas County Road No. 102 and 400 feet East of the West line of the Southwest Quarter (S.W.¼) of Section 2, Township 12 South, Range 19 East, Douglas County, Kansas, thence Easterly on said center line of Road No. 102 a distance of 600 feet and terminating at said point. Cost of the alterations, if any, shall be paid for by Mobil Pipeline Company on county easement and by the county on Mobil Pipeline Company easement. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this Agreement be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried.
