Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board and presented the Board a contract for right-of-way for Project No. 23C-1215-01 Formerly 23 RS-196(1), between the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County and The Kansas Fish and Game Commission, Pratt, Kansas, for 1.063 acres of right-of-way easement, 0.909 acres of temporary easement for construction, and 35 rods of fence, in the lump sum of \$1. After review of this agreement it was moved by Mr. Cragan that it be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried.

Mr. Dooley then presented the Board an Application from United Telephone Company of Kansas, seeking authority to construct a buried telephone cable on Douglas County Route No. 464, in Section 15, Township 14S, Range 19E, in Douglas County, Kansas.
