It should be noted, if the Douglas County Ambulance Service is located at the Lawrence Memorial Hospital site that approximately 30% of this above amount shall be credited to the Owner as that portion would have been a part of our full service contract. However, should the Douglas County Ambulance Service not be located at the Lawrence Memorial Hospital site no credit will be allowed.

- (2) Douglas County Ambulance Service - 1839 Massachusetts Street Facility - General Structural Statility Examination:

Mr. McFarlane recommended that the Board accept the low quote of Electronic Contracting Company, Overland Park, Kansas, in the amount of \$363. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.
