Micc.: Ck.recd.1981 Program Four Seasons The Board noted receipt of check in the amount of \$164.05 for the 1981 Prevented Planting disaster program for the 33 acres in the NW 1 of SE 1 in Section 10, Township 13, Range 19, owned by Douglas County in the Four Seasons Area.

Pul. Works; 1/w 23C-1297-01 Libles Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board and presented the Board a contract for right-of-way for Project No. 23C-1297-01, Formerly 23RS-1528(4), between the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County and Kenneth Paul Gibler and Phyllis Jean Gibler, husband and wife, for 2.453 acres of right-of-way easement and 97 rods of barb fence, in the lump sum of \$3400. This lump sum payment includes allowance for irregularity of fencing, irregularity of boundary, approximately 1.75 acres of brome, and abstracting. After review of this contract it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unani mously.

Pub. Works: Program const. on FAS routes Mr. Dooley then presented a Request for Construction Project whereas the Secretary of Transportation of the State of Kansas has been designated as Agent for Douglas County. The Secretary is hereby requested to program for construction various portions of FAS Routes throughout Douglas County and which includes stop signs. The total estimated cost for this project is \$2600. Douglas County states that sufficient funds are now, or will be, available and are hereby pledged to the Secretary in the amount and at the time required for the Supplementing of Federal funds available for the comletion of this project. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this Request for Construction Project be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

Reg of Deeds: Purch Typewrites Sue Neustifter, register of deeds, appeared before the Board with a quote from IBM Corporation for a corrective, selectric III, dual pitch, 15.5" carriage, electric typewriter, in the amount of \$931.50 with trade-in of \$150, for a total amount of \$781.50. Cottonwood; contract for 1981 The Board discussed an Agreement between Cottonwood, Inc., a non-profit corporation, and the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County. The term of this Agreement shall commence on January 1, 1981 and terminate on December 31, 1981, and the County shall pay to Cottonwood for the services provided, the sum of \$64,000 to be paid at the earliest times of Douglas County tax distributions. In consideration of the payment of said sum, Cottonwood shall furnish and render the services for the mentally retarded as set forth in K.S.A. 19-4001 et seq. as amended. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this Agreement be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.
