The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present. Student representative Diane Powers was also present for the meeting.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of December 31, 1981.

The Board approved Commissioners Cancellation Order No. 3020, 3021, 3022, 3023, and 3024. Orders are on file in the office of the County Clerk.

Treasurer Ruth Vervynck notified the Board that Kelly D. Kultaha terminated on December 31, 1981.

Kathy Hamilton, Valleyview Administrator, recommended employment of the following:

(1) Sandy K. Parker, in the position of nurse aide, temporary, parttime, at the rate of \$3.35 per hour, effective December 23, 1981.

(2) Deidra D. Bethea, in the position of kitchen assistant, temporary, part-time, at the rate of \$3.35 per hour, effective January 2, 1982. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that these recommendations be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

The Board considered Resolution No. 82-1 which resolution relates to granting a cereal malt beverage license to Lionel Edmunds for use at the Clinton Store, Route 5, Lawrence, Kansas. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this resolution be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously
