Mr. Kellum indicated the issuance of thirteen building permits for new homes or additions to residences with a total declared value to be \$443,300. Permits were issued for three mobile homes with a total declared value of \$31,500 and one commercial for a total declared value of \$35,000. The total estimated value for the three months period is \$509,800 and the total fees collected by his department is \$304.10.
