At 11:02 a.m., the Board discussed a planning item with David Guntert, staff member of the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Department. Also in attendance was Wayne Kellum, zoning administrator. The Board considered Item No. 5 from the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission minutes of June 23, 1982, which item is a request for a conditional use permit to construct an electrical substation in Douglas County. The proposed location of the substation is generally described as being located seven miles west of Lawrence on County Road No. 442 (Stull Road) and one-quarter mile north on Kanwaka Township Road No. 27, submitted by Kaw Valley Electric Coop., Topeka, Kansas, for the property owners. This item comes to the Board with a recommendation of approval from the Planning Commission, subject to the following condition:

(1) The control house be located at least 90 feet from the Township Road or a variance be requested and approved by the Board of Zoning Appeals to allow the control house to remain as designated, 50 feet from the centerline of the Township Road.

The Board noted receipt of the Douglas County Board of Zoning Appeals minutes of July 21, 1982, which Board unanimously approved the application of Kaw Valley Electric Coop for their request for the 40 feet set-back variance with a condition that they provide some sort of shrubbery screening outside the substation. The Board of Zoning Appeals approved this requested variance with the intent that the Board of County Commissioners stipulate the location and type of landscape screening to be required. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that the Board concur in the recommendation of the Planning Commission and the Board of Zoning Appeals, but with landscape screening to be approved by the planning staff instead of the Board of County Commissioners seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.
