Nichols and Bonnie M. Nichols, husband and wife, for 0.015 acres of temp-orary easement for construction, in the lump sum of \$50.

(2) Between the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County and The Stull Cemetery Association, President Clifford C. Nichols, for 0.0046 acres of temporary easement for construction, in the lump sum of \$50.

After review of these two contracts it was moved by Mr. Neis that they be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

Dooley then presented the Board an agreement between Douglas County and BG Engineering, Inc., Consulting Engineers, Manhattan, Kansas, whereas the county is authorized and empowered to contract with BG Engineering for the purpose of obtaining professional engineering services for Bridge No. 04.50 02.29E. The county agrees to make payment to BG Engineering on the follow-04.50Ning fee basis:

For the services outlined in Items 1 through 11 of the agreement, the lump sum amount of \$5900, called basic plan fee.

For the services outlined in Items 12 through 15, the work shall be accomplished at the hourly rate of \$50/hr. for a 3-man survey crew and \$28/hr. for an inspector. However, this work shall not exceed the lump sum amount of \$4200 unless specifically authorized by the county.

After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this agreement be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Dooley then presented the Board State of Kansas Secondary Road System, Agreement for Engineering Services, between the County of Douglas and BG Engineering, Inc., Manhattan, Kansas, for construction improvements of 0.1 miles grading and Off-System bridge No. 00.69N-18.00E located on Spring Creek on the west line NW1 Sec. 14, T15S, R20E. The county agrees to make payment to BG Engineering on the following fee basis: For all surveys as required by the tabulation of services, the lump sum amount of \$1200; for preliminary plans for right-of-way and for construction road plans including culverts and surfacing, but not including bridges, the lump sum of \$2200, hereinafter called basic plan fee; and in addition to the basic fee above a lump sum for bridge construction plans of \$1400. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this Agreement for Engineering Services be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Dooley then presented a Request for Construction Project Off-System Roads Program, for Bridge No. 00.69N-18.00E, whereas the State Highway Com-mission of Kansas, has been designated as Agent for Douglas County. The State Highway Commission is hereby requested to program for construction that portion of road on West line NW4 Sec. 14, T15S, R20E to include grading, culverts, and bridge, in the estimated total amount of \$90,000. Douglas County states that sufficient funds are now, or will be available and are hereby pledged to the State Highway Commission in the amount and at the time required for the Supplementing of Federal funds available for the completion of this project. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this Re-quest for Construction Project be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and car-ried unanimously. ried unanimously.
