Vacate. 516-34-1318 parts

At the hour of 9:00 a.m., as advertised, Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board in regard to a Request to Vacate Roads. This request is to vacate part of Road No. 516, part of Road No. 34, and Road No. 318. Mr. Dooley stated that he had not received concurrence from the Eudora Township Board.
