The Board considered Resolution No. 82-38 which resolution relates to granting a cereal malt beverage license to Thomas E. Cyr for use at the Gilded Cage, Route 2, Eudora, Kansas. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this resolution be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Purch shot rock

Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board with two quotes for the purchase and delivery of approximately 1180 tons of shot rock. Mr. Dooley recommended that the Board accept the low quote from Killough, Inc., Ottawa, Kansas, for a cost of \$5.85 per ton for a total amount of \$6903. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Dooley then presented a contract for right-of-way for Bridge No. 15.02N-05.50E, Road No. 4-A, between the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County and George A. Steele and F. Irene Steele, his wife, for 0.094 acres of right-of-way easement and 0.070 acres of temporary easement for construction, in the lump sum of \$57. After review of this contract it was moved by Mr. Neis that it be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Dooley then presented the Board an Agreement between Southwestern Bell Telephone Company and Douglas County for Project No. 82-3. Douglas County intends to improve a portion of Douglas County Road No. 44 and replacement of Bridge No. 09.00N-00.47E described as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter (S.E.1) of Section 35, Township 13 South, Range 17 East, thence East on the South line of said Southeast Quarter (S.E.1) a distance of 67.93 feet and terminating at said point, also beginning at the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter (S.W.1) of Section 35, Township 13 South, Range 17 East, thence West on the South line of said Southwest Quarter (S.W.1) a distance of 782.07 feet and terminating at said point. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this Agreement be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.
