Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board with four quotes for the purchase of regular gasoline, unleaded gasoline, and diesel fuel. Mr. Dooley recommended that the Board accept the low quote of Zaroco, Inc., Lawrence, in the amount of \$0.8860 per gallon for 1300 gallons of regular gasoline, \$0.9160 per gallon for unleaded gasoline, and \$0.7400 per gallon for 2650 gallons of diesel fuel. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.
