If within such period no sufficient protest is filed or if the electors approve such proposition at an election called and held thereon, that portion of the tax levies of such county which is levied for the purpose of paying costs incurred by the county in complying with the provisions of K.S.A. 19-430 et seq. shall not be included in computing the aggregate tax levies of the county and as exempt from the limitations imposed under the provision of K.S.A. 79-5001 to 79-5016, inclusive. After complete review of the details of this resolution it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that the projected budget for 1984 for the county appraiser's office be set for the purpose of publication to be \$286,000, and that the details of this resolution be published in accordance with K.S.A. 19-436 in order that this projected budgeted amount may be exempt from the aggregate tax levy of Douglas County for the budget year 1984. Motion seconded by Mrs. Hiebert and carried unanimously.
