This lump sum payment includes allowance for a concrete and pipe cattle guard and abstracting. After review of this contract it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that it be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Kellum indicates that this request is for a 70 foot easement from Ernest J. Coleman and Hazel M. Coleman, husband and wife, described as follows: Commencing at the NE Corner of Section 28, Township 13 South, Range 19 East, containing 4.87 acres, more or less, all in Douglas County, Kansas. This easement will serve as an ingress and egress for a 15 acre tract of land. It is understood by all present that this will be the third and final house on this 70 foot private road. After review of this request it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that the Board approve this private way for the issuance of the building permit for development of a residence on Mr. Tate's property, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.
