Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board and presented an Authority and Method Procedure Form covering Project No. 23 C-1635-01 (RS 1084[4]) which consists of 0.208 miles of grading and surfacing work on FAS Route 214, in the city of Lecompton. County funds in the approximate amount of \$51,200 will be available for the matching of federal funds to finance construction work on this project. Mr. Dooley then presented a Certification of Peal Property Acquisition Procedures for the same project. This certifies that all real property acquired for the project was done so in compliance with listed procedures which are required by Federal and State law. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that these documents be ap-proved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously. Hub. Works: Procedure form 230-1635-01 Mr. Dooley then presented an Authority and Method Procedure Form covering Project No. 21 C-0330-01 (AHL-PMS 1593[2]) which consists of 0.276 miles of grading, seeding, and surfacing on FAS Route 1966 located at the Junction of US-59/K-10 in Lawrence, W. County funds in the approxiamte amount of \$28,000 will be available for the matching of federal funds to finance construction work on this project. Mr. Dooley then presented a Certification of Real Pro-perty Acquisition Procedures for the same project. This certifies that all real property acquired for the project was done so in compliance with listed procedures which are required by Federal and State law. Improvements will consist of constructing a third traffic lane through the intersections, complete with paving, shouldering, and seeding, to allow for left turning traffic. Subject to the availability of funds, the Government will reimburse Douglas County the sum of \$45,000 for improvements of the intersections of the Clinton Lake Administrative Area Road and the Clinton State Park Access Road with the access road. Upon completion of the subject improvements and satisfactory final inspection, the Government will continue operation and maintenance of that portion of the access road located within the project boundary.
