FAS 1375

Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board and presented a Request for Construction Project whereas the Secretary of Transportation of the State of Kansas has been designated as Agent for Douglas County. The Secretary is hereby requested to program for construction that portion of FAS Route No. 1375, located 2 miles East of U.S. 59, East to FAS 210, which is for surfacing 2.472 miles. The total estimated cost for this project is \$280,000. Douglas County states that sufficient funds are now, or will be, available and are hereby pledged to the Secretary in the amount and at the time required for the Supplementing of Federal funds available for the completion of this project. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this Request for Construction Project be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.
