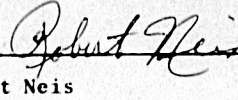

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with two members of the Board present. Mrs. Hiebert was absent due to attending a Job Training Partnership Act meeting at Haskell.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of November 3, 1983.

Jerry Harper, district attorney, notified the Board that Jean Sagan and Harry Warren terminated on November 4, 1983.

Dee Boeck, administrative office assistant in the district attorney's office, appeared before the Board to recommend the employment of Margaret Lindeberg-Johnson, in the position of assistant district attorney, at a salary of \$17,499.96 per year, effective November 8, 1983. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried.

Jerry Kemberling, noxious weed director, appeared before the Board to recommend the purchase of 80 pounds of Tordon 10K, in the total amount of \$204.80, from Mid States, Eudora. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried.

Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board and presented an Application from Southwestern Bell Telephone Company requesting authority to construct buried telephone cable in Section 26, Township 13S, Range 20E. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this Application be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried.

Mr. Dooley then presented correspondence from Mr. Lynn Burris, Jr., State Liaison Officer of The Kansas State Park and Resources Authority, which requests an Annual Operation and Maintenance Assurance Statement on Wells Overlook Regional Park. This Assurance Statement is required of Douglas County since this project was in part funded by the Bureau of Outdoor Recreation funds. The statement includes a number of requirements for maintenance and appearance of the facility and a certification of non-discrimination in the use of the facility. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this Assurance Statement be executed and returned to the state for signing by the State Park and Resources Authority, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried.

Mrs. Hiebert joined the Board at 11:10 a.m.

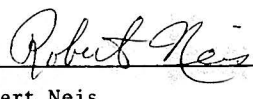

Four bids were received.
