Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board and presented the Board three contracts for highway purposes for Project No. 23C-1805-01, Road No. 13-A, for the following:

(1) Between the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County and Paul G. Brecheisen and Mary L. Brecheisen, husband and wife, recorded owners, and Marvin G. Smith, a single person, contract buyer, for 0.198 acres of right-of-way easement, 0.161 acres of temporary easement for construction, 5 rods of barb fence, and 13 rods of woven fence, in the lump sum of \$582. This lump sum payment includes allowance for relocating decorative fence (wooden) and abstracting.

(2) Between the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County and Paul G. Brecheisen and Mary L. Brecheisen, husband and wife, recorded owners and Ivan M. Wiseman and Patricia Ann Wiseman, husband and wife, contract buyers, for 0.034 acres of right-of-way easement, and 7 rods of barb fence, in the lump sum of \$193. This lump sum payment includes allowance for abstracting.

(3) Between the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County and Russell Rohe and Mildred Rohe, husband and wife, for 0.155 acres of right-of-way easement, 0.146 acres of temporary easement for construction and 43 rods of barb fence, in the lump sum of \$731. This lump sum payment includes allowance for 13 rods of temporary fence and abstracting.

After review of these three contracts it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that they be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.
