Wayne Kellum, zoning administrator, presented the Board Resolution No. 84-18. By this resolution it is unanimously resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County that under the "Zoning Regulations for the Unincorporated Territory of Douglas County, Kansas," the following changes in zoning classification be made: Zoning classification is changed from A (Agricultural) to B-3 (Limited Business District) on a recorded subdivision plat described as Miller's Subdivision also, zoning classification is changed from A (Agricultural) to A-1 (Suburban Home Residential) on a recorded subdivision plat described as Rolling Hills Estates. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this resolution be approved and published in accordance with the requirements of the law, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.

Purch Drapes & rods

Ruth Foster, Valleyview administrator, appeared before the Board and presented the Board three quotes for the purchase of draperies and traverse rods. Mrs. Foster recommended that the Board accept the low quote from Jane Bateman, Lawrence, for 10 rods and 10 pairs of draperies with fire retardant fabric and lining, and installation, in the total amount of \$1760.
