At the advertised hour of 9:00 a.m., David Guntert, Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Department staff member, appeared before the Board to hold a public hearing for the purpose to consider the merits of the request from the City of Lawrence to deannex approximately 58.78 acres of property, generally described as being located on the west side of Crossgates Drive and south of West 26th Street, from the corporate limits of Lawrence. Doctor Richard Nelson was also present for this hearing. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that the Board take this matter under advisement and to set up a date in the near future that is convenient with the city to discuss this item, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.

At the hour of 10:00 a.m., Mike Dooley, public works director, opened three bids for the purchase of two new roadside mowers with trade-in of two 1977 mowers. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that the Board take the bids under advisement, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Dooley then opened two quotes for the purchase of regular gasoline, unleaded gasoline, and diesel fuel. Mr. Dooley recommended that the Board accept the low quote from Zaroco Inc., Lawrence, for the following: 1300 gallons of regular gasoline at \$0.9512 per gallon, 5300 gallons of unleaded gasoline at \$0.9812 per gallon, and 1700 gallons of diesel fuel at \$0.8085 per gallon. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.
