Ordered by the board that the County Tax in every township be equal to the Territorial Tax

Ordered that the grocery License be ten Dollars and one half of one per cent upon all sales over one thousand dollars

The board appointed Lecompton Lawrence and Willow-Spring each an election precinct

The board appointed A. B. Mack Calvin Adams and Wesley Duncan Judges of an election for the Laurens Precinct to be held on the 6th of Oct 1836

The board appointed H. Dutcher J. H. Braddy and Timothy Huger Judges of an election for Willow Spring Precinct to be held on the 6th of Oct. A.D. 1836

The board now adjourn until the next Regular Term in Oct 1836
