The Hon. the board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment Hon C. N. O. D. Ward President and John Spicer Presiding No Sheriff being present James P. Pucker was appointed who proclaimed that the Court was now in session

The board authorized the clerk to rent a suitable office for a clerks office and to pay on the credit of the county

The board ^{authorized} appointed the clerk to have a suitable desk made for the keeping of the Public Records and also seats and stationery

The board postponed the letting out of the contract for building a jail for Douglas County until the first Monday in Dec and the clerk is authorized to issue orders to that effect

The board now adjourn until the first Monday in Dec 1856

The board appoint James M. Hinton County Commissioner in place of Geo. M. Banks removed from the Territory

The board Read the resignation of Samuel J. Jones as Sheriff of Douglas County to take effect this day

The board appointed William J. Sherman to the office of Sheriff of Douglas County in place Samuel J. Jones resigned
The board then ordered J. M. D. Ward for a clerk & clerk office for the year 1857
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
