

Monday February 2nd A.D. 1837

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The Hon the Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment present Hon. John P. Word President Hon. John Spicer and James M. Senter presiding

The board was organized by proclamation of Wesley Garrison Sheriff at the Court house door

The board ordered that a jail should be built in the city of Decatur upon the plan submitted to the board by Hon. John Spicer and filed in the clerk's office

Ordered by the board that Wesley Garrison is required to give notice that sealed proposals will be received at the clerk's office until the third Monday in February 1837 for building said jail; and that the contract be let to the lowest responsible bidder, the board reserving the right to reject any or all bids

The Board now adjourn until the third Monday in this month

The Board appointed Percis Eldon Supervisor of a Supervisor of a County Road from Decatur to Benicia through the bottom

The Board appointed William Yates Supervisor of a Road from the East boundary line of Benicia to the East boundary of Calvin Adams claim

The Board appointed Martin Adams a Supervisor of a County road from the East boundary of Calvin Adams claim to Lawrence
