Ordered by the Board that the Court House in Leecompton Voting Precinct be the Place of Voting on Monday the 15th day of this inst for the purposes of electing delegates to a constitutional Convention to be held at Leecompton Kansas Territory in September next and Henry Gamble, George W. Henry and William A. Cardwell be and are hereby appointed Judges of said election

Ordered by the Board that Bloomington be the Voting Precinct of Washington Township for an election to be held on the 15th day of this inst for the purposes of electing delegates to a constitutional Convention to be held at Leecompton Kansas Territory in September next and that John Campbell, P. P. Fowler and Joseph P. Peterson be and are hereby appointed Judges of said election

Ordered by the Board that Palmyra be the Voting Precinct for Calhoun Township for an election to be held on the 15th day of this inst for the purposes of electing delegates to a Constitutional Convention to be held at Leecompton in September next, and that William McKinney, John Smith, and Hugh Casner be and are hereby appointed Judges of said election

Ordered by the Board that Lawrence be the Voting Precinct for Wakarusa Township for an election to be held the 15th day of this inst for the purposes of electing delegates to a Constitutional Convention to be held at Leecompton in September next and that Charles Duncan, Samuel Evans, and James S. Liggate be and are hereby appointed Judges of said election

Ordered by the Board that the Clerk Delifer Williams D. Hain, appear to appear before the Board on Monday the eight day of this inst and show cause if any he has why he has not made the return of the defers books in accordance to law regulating the same

Ordered by the Board that the Board now adjourn until Monday the 8th day of this inst
