The Board being duly organized the following proceedings
 were had.

The Petition of Thirty four citizens of
 Douglas County, praying for a Bridge across the
 Frankama at the point where the road leading from
 Lawrence to Osawatomie by way of Palmyra (laid out by
 Commissioners appointed by the Board and whose report and
 map is filed March 12. 1858 and accepted.) crosses the same
 was read, and after deliberating thereon the Board
 ordered that the sum of One Thousand Dollars be levied
 and raised upon the County of Douglas to defray the expense
 of constructing said bridge.
