

The Board being duly organized the following proceedings were had.

The account of J. W. O.P. Wood for house rent  
fuel & stationery, amounting to \$300 as per bill on file having been

not being minuted was taken up and allowed and a  
mandant ordered to be issued for the same, and also for the  
account of the said Wood, allowed on the same day a draft  
from the minister pay 33 off the book, for \$108.50 and ordered was  
that the said certificate granted to said Wood be cancelled  
and a new mandant issued.

The Petition for a road running from Lawrence to Twin  
Mounds was presented and read and ordered to be filed.  
The following Commissioners were appointed J.W. Evans E. T. Maynard  
and A. H. Seal to survey and locate said road.

The Board adjourned to meet at its next regular session.
