ted as a Commissioner to view the road from Lawrence to
Leavenworth to be called the middle route has failed to per-
form his duty as such, it was Ordered that Mr. Oliver
Beale and is hereby appointed a Commissioner for the said pur-
pose

The petition of Wm. Jesse, P.H. Parker, Almon Swain
and others for a road from Leavenworth to Bloomington
Minerals and to the county line near Mineola was re-
curred and ordered filed. The following persons were ap-
pointed Commissioners to view said road vizt. James
Smith, Robt Bishop, G.W. Farno

Ordered That Robert Morrow, J. M. Wickizer
and C.H. Branscomb be and are hereby ap-
