

The Petition of H. Benson & Others for a road from the Town of Clinton to the Town of New Haven passing the N. East corner of the farm of Mr. Joseph Eberhart was taken up and the following persons were appointed commissioners to view said road J. H. Dancy H. Ben. son, R. G. Peabody

The Petition signed by Mr. Jesse, P. H. Burkaw and others for a road from Seecompton to Bloomingford Minersville and to the County line near Minersville, was received, and the following commissioners were appointed to view said road Mr. W. L. Wimer Robert Bishop & Grinnell Smith

The Petition of Mr. Jesse, P. H. Burkaw and others for a road from Lawrence to A. Lake crossing of the Wakarusa, thence to Bloomingford & then around was taken received and the following commissioners were appointed to view said roads Mr. Messrs. H. Seal P. H. Peabody and G. H. Hare

The Petition of Mr. D. Barber Paul Cheney & others for a road commencing on the Lawrence and Palmyra road near Graditts Mill, in Township 14 Range 20 thence north on the line between sections 22 and 23 and continue north on said line or as convenient to the California road East of Franklin, was taken up and the following commissioners were appointed to view said road Oliver Johnson Mr. Jones, A. Soule

The commissioners appointed to view and mark out a road from the foot of Kentucky Street Lawrence to a point opposite Minersville in Franklin County on the line between the Counties of Douglas and Franklin, submitted their report which was accepted and placed on file

The commissioners appointed by the Territorial Legislature at Seecompton February 27, 1857 to locate a road from Seecompton by the way of Clinton to the Sac and Fox Agency met March 16, 1857, made their report and the report was accepted and adopted and the Commissioners were authorized to survey and establish the said Territorial road.

The Petition of H. H. Haw Salem Stearns and others for a road from the Township line which forms the West boundary of the City of Lawrence and from the centre Street of the Town of Brooklyn (10 miles south) and runs through this City in the adjoining County was received and the following commissioners were appointed, to view said road L. A. Hawscon, H. Seal J. M. Hagelthine
