Petition for a road from Prairie City to Lawrence on the line described as follows Beginning at or near the north east corner of the north east quarter of section eight in township fifteen south of range twenty east, thence north on the section line dividing sections eight and nine in said township to the intersection of the road already established to the town of Palmyra, thence on said Palmyra road to the City of Lawrence was received and the following commissioners were appointed Samuel Smith D. M. Hazelthorn A. H. Seal

The report of the commissioners appointed to view and mark out a road from the foot of Kentucky Street ^{Highway of New Haven} Lawrence to a point opposite Minnola in Franklin County on the line between the County of Douglas, and Franklin was taken from the file and it was ordered that the said road be opened and kept in repair no objection having been made to said highway
