 John Baldwin on the payment of \$200.00, and giving
 bonds, with security in the sum of \$2000.

The rates of ferriage at said ferry were fixed as
 follows

For two horse vehicles	50¢
one yoke of cattle & wagon	50¢
each additional yoke of	20¢
Cattle or pair of horses	
one horse & rider	20¢
one horse & chain & buggy	25¢
cattle per head	10¢
sheep & swine per head	3¢
footmen ea	10¢

From 10 P.M. till 4 A.M. double
 the usual rates are allowed
