14th day of October, 1858 in the Township of
Lawrence County of Douglas Territory of Kan-
sas George Ford was duly elected to the office of
Chairman of the Board of Supervisors for said Town-
ship in said County & Territory

Now therefore I, James W. Denver Governor
of the Territory of Kansas by virtue of the au-
thority in me vested do hereby commission
the said George Ford as Chairman of Board
of Supervisors for said Township, in said Coun-
ty and Territory for and during the term pre-
scribed by law

ed the seal of the Territory aforesaid Done at
the City of Leavenworth this 8th day of October
in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight
hundred and fifty eight
