Records of preceding meeting read and approved

The Comr on the account of E. D. Ladd for services as Justice of the Peace &c, reported recommending that said acc be allowed except for that portion charged for writing down testimony since the law of July 1858 in relation to fees of Justice of the Peace.

It was ordered that the account of E. D. Ladd be allowed as recommended by the Committee & the chairman and Clerk were instructed to put up said account making the reduction reported by the Committee.

The Committee to whom was referred the account of Joseph Cracklin for services as Constable reported the same as correct the report was received and the said account was allowed at \$29.35

The Committee to whom was referred the subject of securing sites for the location of County Buildings reported progress and asked for further time which was granted.

By request of the Board Mr. J. G. Haskell who had been employed by the Committee to prepare a plan for a County Jail presented and explained said plan to the Board.

The account of Samuel Walker Sheriff for serving Subpoenas, warrants and other writs returnable to the 2^d District Court of Douglas County and for attending said Court was allowed at \$169.79

The account of S. W. Wood which had been returned to him for correcting was presented and referred to a com of three who reported the same back as correct for 153.20

The report of the Committee was received and the account was allowed as recommended in the report of the Committee.
