

to the Board, that application for said road was then made by a petition signed by householders of the townships through which said road passes, three of whom were of the immediate neighbourhood, specifying the proposed beginning, course and termination thereof with not more than two points, named in such petition on the direction of said road.

That notice of such intended application was given by according to law.

That the Commissioner duly qualified and no less proceeded to view the route proposed in said petition & to lay out and mark such ground for said road according to law, and reported a road to said Board as per report and plat on file.

And, a legal remonstrance signed by ten householder in said township being made and presented to said Board, the Commissioner being duly appointed notified and qualified forwarded report on said road as to its utility proceeded to view said road in accordance therewith and thereupon reported to said Board that said road was and is of utility - it is therefore ordered that the said road be opened.

On motion alledge Scudder Flansing and Hart were appointed a committee to draft a list of rates of toll for the bridge known as Blanton's Bridge.

The Board adjourned till one o'clock P.M. - One o'clock P.M.

The Committee to whom was referred the subject of establishing a list of rates of toll for Blanton's bridge reported a list. The report was received and laid on the table.

Clerk John G. Haskell made some statement by request of the Board of the probable cost of iron bridge across the Nakawas.

A proposition from Mr. Ellorson was presented and read and it was ordered that the same be received and placed on file.

After considering the proposition of Mr. Ellorson it was ordered that the same be accepted and that the building be proceeded at as early a day as practicable for the use of the County. It was further ordered that the Clerk may be authorized to make the contract in behalf of the County with Mr. Ellorson, prepare and sign for the County the necessary instruments of writing to complete said contract in accordance with said proposition.
