The a/c of J. H. Clemens for services as Bailiff to Grand Jury September term Dis Court Douglas County and services as Judge of Election Oct 1857 & 24th - was allowed at \$25.00

The account of E. D. Ladd was taken from the table

A motion to allow the account as presented was lost

It was ordered that the account be referred back to Mr. Ladd for correcting relating to charges for Suffering according to law

The account of S. W. Wood for services as Justice of the Peace was allowed at \$153.20

Mr. Ford to whom had been referred the matter of completing the contract with Mr. Elorson for the building of a court house and preparing and signing writings in behalf of the County. to complete said contract reported a further proposition from Mr. Elorson offering the basement of said building. It was ordered that the County accept the proposition of Mr. Elorson to the County at \$100.00 per year and Mr. Ford was thereupon authorized and instructed to make sign the necessary writings to include the contract under said proposition

The a/c of C. S. Mandell for services as Surveyor &c which had been referred to the Chairman was reported as correct and allowed at \$128.00

The resolution presented at the last meeting in relation to instructing the County Treasurer not to pay any County orders dated previous to the 24th day of October 1857 was taken from the table and adopted
