On motion of Mr. Ramsey It was ordered that the rate of tolls for crossing the Bridge known as Blanton's Bridge shall be as follows viz:

" Each additional pair of Oxen & Horses	5 -

Loose Cattle per Head 1 -

Sheep & Swine 1/2 -

One or more Horses being led 2 1/2 - each

This order to be in force from and after Nov. 13. 1858

On motion Messrs. Isaac Ramsey & Scudder were appointed a committee to confer with Mr. Brittain in relation to purchase of this bridge known as Blanton's Bridge

The account of D. G. Readdy for services as Surveyor on Territorial Road \$60- was allowed at \$60-

The fee of C. D. Sudd for services as Justice of the Peace \$7.50 was allowed at \$7.50

The fee of C. D. Sudd for services as Justice of the Peace was referred back to him with instructions to correct the same

The fee of Josiah Miller for rent of office for Probate Court & Reg. of Deeds, fuel, stationery, &c. was referred back to him for items of said fuel stationery, &c.
