The age of Samuel Walker for service as Sheriff was allowed at \$61.71⁰⁰ appropriation No. 3 for Judicial Expenses.

Resolved by the Board of County Supervisors of Douglas County K.S. that immediate measures be taken to secure the erection of County Jail

2d That G.G. Haskell is hereby appointed architect and superintendent of the plan and construction of the same

3d That a Committee of three be appointed to take into consideration a plan of E. Jacobs & Co. of Cincinnati presented by A.B. G. Haskell and report at the meeting of the Board tomorrow

4th That the commission of G.G. Haskell for plan and superintendence of said jail be five per cent on ten thousand dollars or five hundred dollars

Messrs. Ford, Starr and Scudder were appointed said committee

Resolved That in case the City Council of the City of Lawrence do not appropriate money for the repair of the County Jail, that the County will have the said jail put in repair, and that the City authorities will be notified not to use said building for City purposes

A notice from J.B. Gilliland Justice of the Peace of Lawrence Township in relation to Albert Wright a pauper, and a petition in regard to the same subject was presented and it appearing to the Board that said pauper had not resided 12 months in the County the petition was not entertained

The petition of J.S. Andre and others for a road from Lawrence west on the Township line where the road from Leavenworth to Bloomington ^{crosses said line} was presented and it appearing to the Board that twenty three free holders of the County six of whom reside in the immediate neighbourhood of the proposed highway and that notice of this application has been posted in three of the most public places in the neigh-
