Committee to whom the subject of a plan for the County jail had been referred reported as follows

To the Honorable Board of County Supervisors
Gentl.

Your committee to whom was referred the subject of deciding upon and reporting a plan for a county jail would respectfully report as follows that we recommend the adoption of Messrs. Jacobs & Co's plan etc one (as shown by J. G. Haskell) with the following alterations viz that there be twelve cells 5x7 feet in the first story instead of ten cells, 6x7 feet and that the height of the said first story be reduced one foot so as to be seven feet instead of eight. That the second be composed of six cells, 7x10 feet instead of ten cells, 6x7 feet that the distance between the outside & inside door be twenty four inches instead of fifteen inches as proposed and that the window in the inside door be diversified with
