The Governor of the Territory of Kansas to all to whom these presents shall come Greeting: Knowye that at an election held on the 28th day of March in the Township of Millon Springs County of Douglas Territory of Kansas Samuel Hindman was duly elected to the office of Chairman of Board of Supervisors of said Township in said County aforesaid.

Now therefore I, Samuel Cledary Governor of the Territory of Kansas by virtue of the authority in me vested do hereby commission the said Samuel Hindman as Chairman of Board of Supervisors of said Township in said County aforesaid for and during the time prescribed by law.

In testimony whereof I have hereunto subscribed my hand and caused to be affixed the seal of the Territory aforesaid. Done at the City of Leominster this 13th day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty nine.
