Now therefore I Hugh S. Walsh Secretary and acting Governor of the Territory of Kansas by virtue of the authority in me vested do hereby appoint and Commission the said J. A. Beam as Chairman of Board of Supervisors of Clinton Township for and during the term prescribed by law which is the unexpired term

In testimony whereof I have hereunto subscribed my hand and caused to be affixed the seal of the Territory aforesaid Done at the City of Leavenworth this 13th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty nine
