R. 18 thence north to the Kansas River thence westerly along said river to county line thence South to place of beginning. Year and days. on the foregoing order being called mounted as follows Year of day Ford, Beaman, Heiman, Cole, & Rogers. May. Thence. It was further ordered that the voting place for said precinct be at the town of Big Springs.

Noted That all that part of Lawrence Township, lying north of the Wakarusa River be and is hereby established and created a voting precinct and that the voting place for said precinct shall be at Blanton - so called.
