being called resulted as follows West along Ford, Beam  
Hinman, Cole, & Rogers' Nay. Hinman It was further or-  
dered that the voting place for said precinct be at the town  
of Big Springs

Ordered that all that part of Lawrence Township, lying west  
of the Wakaw River be and is hereby established and  
created a voting precinct and that the voting place  
for said precinct shall be at Blanton - so called
