Board met pursuant to adjournment

It was Resolved that the Board fix the salary of the Probate Judge at \$12500 per year up to the 19th day of July inst. and for the balance of his term of office he be paid at the rate of \$6000 per year

It was Resolved that an order be drawn on the Com. Treasury in favor of said officer Probate Judge for \$5000 in addition to \$1000 already paid, to be in full for his salary to 19th July inst. App. 21.

It was Resolved that a certain contract with Edwards & Co. for one Iron Rail the same being contrary to Law is of no binding force on the people of Douglas County.

Whereas the Board of County Supervisors of Douglas Co. did make a certain contract with Edwards & Co. of Cincinnati to erect an Iron Rail for the use of said County at a cost of more than \$10,000 and Whereas the present Co. Board believe the law limits the amount to \$10,000 Therefore Resolved that the question of a loan of \$17,500 for the purpose of erecting a rail at the Co. Seat be submitted to a vote of the people of this County on Tuesday the 4th day of Oct next and that the Co. Clerk be authorized to give notice by 4 publications in each of the papers published in Douglas Co.

Whereas it is understood & believed that a certain man by the name of Dulinski keeps a Rum & Beer Shop in the Township of Lawrence in violation of the Laws of this Territory, and be it further Resolved that the Co. Attorney be and he is hereby required to enforce the law against him in such cases made and provided and that the Clerk of this Board be instructed to notify said attorney, in writing, of the order of the Board

Resolved that an appropriation of \$110. to pay the Int. due Sept. 1st on Bonds of this Co. and that the Co. Treasurer be requested to use the stray money Licensed or School money in his hands to be replaced when the Cherry Licenses are paid

Resolved that the License for the Ferry at Leconte be fixed at \$50-
