

Woodward and others to divide the present Township of Laurence may presented and accepted and it was ordered that Laurence Township shall consist of all that portion of the now present Township of Laurence lying within the limits of the City of Laurence, and that all that portions of Laurence Township lying outside of the City of Laurence shall be erected and established as a Township, to be called Wakarusa Township. this order to take Effect and be in force from and after the 4th Monday of March A.D. 1860

The account of Levi Woodward for service as Supervisor was allowed at \$3 to be paid out of app. 2 for General Expenses

The account of G. H. Reed for service as Trust was rejected

The account of C. J. Edwards for service as Superintendent of Common School was allowed at \$175.50 to be paid out of app. 6 for Contingent Expenses

Resolved That this Board will no longer recognize the authority of the Co. Superintendent of School to appoint and employ a deputy and will pay no bills presented for such service after this date
