

The petition of Daniel Scammell, John Piratt and others praying for the establishment of a voting precinct at the town of Franklin was presented and accepted.

It was ordered that there be and here by is established a voting precinct at the town of Franklin in Douglas County.

The said Petitioners having requested the Board to appoint Judges of Election at said Precinct it was ordered that J. B. Gilliland, R. S. Williams and L. A. Prather be and are appointed Inspectors of Election at the first election to be held at said Precinct.

Whereas At a meeting of the Board of County Supervisors, the Township of Lawrence was divided into two townships setting apart a new township embracing all part of Lawrence Township except the City of Lawrence to be called the Township of Wakarusa.

Therefore, resolved that the Board of Co. Supervisors hereby authorized the first Township meeting of the Township of Wakarusa for the election of Township officers to be held at the House of Mr. Sylvester Dulinski on the day fixed by law and that the County Clerk of Lawrence Township be instructed to issue the legal notices for said Township meeting.

It was ordered that the Clerk of this Board is hereby instructed to procure an additional Jury Box for the use of this, Douglas County.

The Board proceeded to make a list of persons to serve as petit jurors and a list of persons to serve as grand jurors for the ensuing year (See list on file)
