The Petition of Peter Kappenan for license to run a ferry on the Kansas River at Eudora was presented and it was ordered that the Clerk be and is hereby instructed to issue a license to the said Peter Kappenan as aforesaid upon the payment of a tax of ten dollars and that the said petitioner give bond according to law in the sum of One Thousand Dollars

Ordered that the authority heretofore granted to Mr John G. Heastell to negotiate the bonds of this County be and is hereby revoked

The Clerk was instructed to obtain the bonds of Douglas County now in the hands of said Heastell mark them cancelled upon their face and present to the Board at their next meeting

Resolved that this Board will audit no accounts for supplies for County affairs except such supplies be furnished upon the written order of the County Clerk all such orders to accompany bills presented for payment

Resolved 2^d That all supplies for the County Jail and prisoners shall be furnished only upon the written order of the Sheriff such order to accompany bills presented for payment

Resolved that the County Clerk be instructed to issue proposals for the printing for the use of the County for the ensuing year said proposals to be sealed and opened at the next meeting of the Board
