Board of Supervisors met pursuant  
to adjournment

stray be cancelled.

Stray taken up by G. W. Clark as per  
said order it was ordered that the record  
of said stray be cancelled. The matter of  
strays taken up by Wesley Garrett  
James Whit, James Brandon, John Haacker  
Stephen Crockett, G. W. Brown, P. Ellison  
R. M. Phillips, John O. Sullivan, Clarkin  
Barn, Andrew White, Isaac Shirley  
Elmore Allen, as per said order were sever-  
ally referred to the County Attorney

In the matter of strays taken up by  
D. W. Deuten, E. B. Roberts, D. C. Halbert,  
Nolan P. Cloore, and Jacob C. Badden  
and Stokes and Perry it was ordered that  
the record of said strays be cancelled.

The Sheriff was instructed to take posses-  
ion of horse taken up by Thomas B. Gra-  
ham and to sell the same according to  
law in compliance with said order.

In the matter of the stray taken up by  
D. O. Lindsley as per said order it was  
ordered that an alias order to the  
Sheriff be issued.

Resolved that the County Clerk  
instruct the County Attorney to write  
to all parties in stray matters which are  
referred to him and not make any ex-  
pense to the County where there is not  
a reasonable prospect of obtaining  
money to pay the same.
