

Ordered that the Chairman of this Board and County Clerk be instructed to make a final settlement with the County Treasurer at the expiration of his term of office

The Clerk presented a statement in writing setting forth the number of strays that have been posted for a longer time than twelve months, and that have not been claimed and proven by the owners according to law, to wit:

It was ordered that said strays be sold by the Sheriff in accordance with law, and that he pay the proceeds on according to law

Whereas certain parties having taken up strays and presented bills to the County for expenses incurred in keeping said strays, and whereas the Board of County Supervisors believe and understand the law respecting strays to give one half the proceeds of sale of such strays (after deducting incidental expenses) to the taker up in consideration of such keeping

Therefore Resolved that the Sheriff of this County be instructed to allow no bills or accounts upon settlement with takers up of strays for keeping or other expenses except fees allowed by law

Ordered that a seal for the Board of Supervisors of Douglas County with the device as follows
