 was received and approved

The report of Comptroller County Treas-
 urer of Douglas County was received
 and approved

The Board proceeded to equalize the
 valuations of the real estate in the
 several townships in this County and
 it was ordered that the valuations
 in the following be changed as follows
 to wit:

Palmyra aggregate valuation of lands
 decreased 25 per cent amounting to
 \$49,995.45

Clinton aggregate valuation of lands
 increased 6 per cent amounting to
 \$13,747.38

Marion aggregate valuation of lands
 increased 60 per cent amounting to
 \$43,820.53

Willow Springs aggregate valuation
 of lands increased 2 per cent amounting to
 \$3,049.31

LeCompton aggregate valuation of
 lands increased 12 1/2 per cent amounting to
 \$20,034.50

Eudora aggregate valuation of
 lands increased 100 per cent amounting to
 \$6,520.
