The report of the Clerk of the Board of the accounts allowed by the Board during the previous year with vouchers accompanying the same was examined and approved

It was ordered that the sum of Four Hundred Dollars be and is hereby appropriated towards defraying the expenses of erecting a bridge across the Wakarusa on road from Decompton to Clinton

and that the sum of Four Hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated towards defraying the expenses of erecting a bridge across the Wakarusa near Gates Crossing both of said appropriations to be subject to the conditions required under resolution passed by this Board at a meeting held May 23rd, 1859, appropriating money for certain bridges

J. G. Haskell returned certain funds amounting to \$2,000 heretofore placed in his hands to negotiate for and on behalf of this County as per resolution passed January 18, 1859, and thereupon the Board destroyed said funds

In the matter of Sarah Clapperton an insane pauper, the said pauper having been declared an insane person by the Probate Court it was ordered that this Board do not consider said pauper a county charge

Resolved, That the Supervisors of Douglas County petition the Territorial Legislature of to pass an act giving the people of Douglas County a vote for the County seat
